

NTEU SURVEY RESULTS




Parents in the United States have a positive view of a career with the federal government yet only 37 percent of those polled have encouraged their child to consider a career in the federal government. Here are some key findings of a nationwide online survey conducted for the National Treasury Employees Union (NTEU) by the polling firm Ipsos Public Affairs between July 21-28, 2014. The survey was taken by parents with children 8-22 years of age.

Parents' views on federal government jobs:

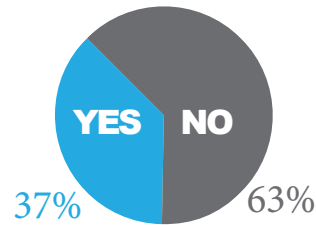
76% agree that federal employees provide important services to the public.
